4. All academic, co-curricular and extracurricular activities shall be appropriately documented with notices, attendance records, reports and photographs.
5. Faculty members shall make appropriate provision for compensatory/remedial classes wherever teaching days are affected due to unforeseen circumstances.
6. Student participation in seminars, workshops, sports, cultural programmes, extension activities and community engagement shall be encouraged without compromising regular academic work.
7. The IQAC shall periodically review implementation of the Academic Calendar and recommend quality-enhancement measures wherever necessary.
